CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Anthony P. Scully called the Camden City Council Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council, on motion by Councilmember Polk, seconded by Councilmember Parks, voted unanimously to adopt the June 11, 2013, City Council Work Session Meeting Minutes and the June 11, 2013, City Council Regular Meeting Minutes.

ORDINANCE #13-015 1st Reading
