ORDINANCE #13-020 2nd Reading

Council, on motion by Councilmember Polk, seconded by Councilmember Parks, voted unanimously to approve second reading of an Ordinance authorizing the receipt of an easement on property owned by Historic Camden Foundation.

ORDINANCE #14-001 1st Reading

Council, on motion by Councilmember Polk, seconded by Councilmember Parks, followed by discussion, voted unanimously to approve first reading of an Ordinance designating certain properties as Local Historic Sites.

ORDINANCE #14-002 1st Reading

Council, on motion by Councilmember Drakeford, seconded by Councilmember Polk, followed by comments from City Manager Mel Pearson and discussion from Council, voted unanimously to approve first reading of an Ordinance consenting to an application for a cable franchise, setting franchise fees and repealing certain provisions of the Code of Ordinances.



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RESOLUTION #14-001

Council, on motion by Councilmember Polk, seconded by Councilmember Parks, voted unanimously to approve a Resolution supporting the Municipal Association's 2014 Legislative Agenda to direct more local decision making to the local elected officials that govern the state's 270 cities and towns.
