### **SPECIAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

Mrs. Polly Lampshire, Chair of the Price House Commission reported that the Price House Commission raised funds for and installed new period appropriate light fixtures for the Price House. The Price House Commission also purchased 6 new round tables, with intent of gifting them to the city on behalf of the Price House.

### **ORDINANCE # 2016-014 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading**

Council, on motion by Councilmember Parks, seconded by Councilmember Davis, voted unanimously to approve second reading of an ordinance authorizing to set forth certain modifications and amendments to Chapters 93, 150 and 153 of the Code of Laws of the City of Camden to conform with changes to the SC Building Codes Council adoption of the International Existing Building Code.

### **ORDINANCE # 2016-015 1<sup>st</sup> Reading**

Council, on motion by Councilmember Parks, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Drakeford, followed by discussion from council, voted unanimously to approve first reading of an



ordinance amending certain sections of the Land Development Regulations of the City of Camden pertaining to Complete Streets; and other matters related thereto.

**ORDINANCE # 2016-016 1<sup>st</sup> Reading**

Council, on motion by Councilmember Parks, seconded by Councilmember Davis, followed by comments from City Planner Shawn Putnam and discussion from council, voted unanimously to approve first reading of an ordinance amending certain articles of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Camden pertaining to building heights; and other matters related thereto.

**RESOLUTION #2016-022**

Council, on motion by Councilmember Parks, seconded by Councilmember Davis, followed by comments from Council, voted unanimously to approve a resolution committing the City of Camden to provide a local match for a Municipal Association of South Carolina Hometown Economic Development Grant. The grant in the amount of \$25,000 requires 10 percent matching funds, or \$2,500, from the city.

**RESOLUTION #2016-023**

Council, on motion by Councilmember Graham, seconded by Councilmember Davis, voted unanimously to approve a resolution authorizing consumption of beer and wine at the 2016 Carolina Downhome Blues Festival.

**RESOLUTION #2016-024**

Council, on motion by Councilmember Graham, seconded by Councilmember Davis, voted unanimously to approve a resolution authorizing consumption of beer and wine at United Way of Kershaw County Chili Cook-Off.

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Drakeford, seconded by Councilmember Davis, voted unanimously to reappoint Mr. Johnny Deal to the Planning Commission with term to expire on August 31, 2020.
