ORDINANCE # 2016-017 1st Reading

Council, on motion by Councilmember Parks, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Drakeford, voted unanimously to approve first reading of an ordinance approving the financing of the sewer line rehabilitation and replacement of the City of Camden, South Carolina, through the borrowing of not exceeding seven million five hundred thousand dollars (\$7,500,000), plus capitalized interest, if any, from the State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund, by agreement with the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority, pursuant to Title 48, Chapter 5, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended; providing for the agreement to make and to accept a loan, the execution and delivery of a loan agreement between the City of Camden, South Carolina and the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority, the execution and delivery of a promissory note from the City of Camden, South Carolina to the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority; and other matters relating thereto.

ORDINANCE # 2016-018 1st Reading

improvements of the City of Camden, South Carolina, through the borrowing of not exceeding six million five hundred thousand dollars (\$6,500,000), plus capitalized interest, if any, from the state drinking water Revolving Loan Fund, by agreement with the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority, pursuant to Title 48, Chapter 5, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended; providing for the agreement to make and to accept a loan, the execution and delivery of a loan agreement between the City of Camden, South Carolina and the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority, the execution and delivery of a promissory note from the City of Camden, South Carolina to the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority; and other matters relating thereto.
