



To showcase its continued commitment to recycling efforts, the city of Camden is offering a pilot program with a limited number of 65-gallon recycling bins which will be **3.5 times larger** than the current recycling containers allowing for more space for weekly recyclables.

To qualify you must:

- Be a residential sanitation customer of the city of Camden
- Agree to use the container for recycling debris only
- Trade in the existing container

To sign up:

There are a limited number of bins; therefore, they will be handed out on a first come, first serve basis. If you would like to sign up for a 65-gallon recycling bin, please fill out the bottom of this form and drop it off at City Hall. Important to know:

- It is not necessary to separate your recyclables
 - Please continue to breakdown all cardboard boxes
 - Any boxes that are unable to fit in the bin should be bundled and set next to the container
 - City crews will pick up the old container when they deliver the new container
- *Please do not bring any containers to City Hall.
